Booster Football/Marching Assignments

Bus Chaperones – Two per Bus are required and will account for students before leaving and prior to returning home so no-one is left behind. Responsible for having the first-aid kit, bus bag with essentials, and completing the checklists for the trips. Each person assigned to be a bus chaperones riding the bus will be included in the provided meal count for the trip.

Hat plumes – Two people will be assigned to make sure the plumes are loaded on the equipment trailer. Also responsible for attaching plumes to the student's performance hats prior to each performance and to retrieve them once the performance is over. Assure they are loaded back on the equipment trailer and unloaded back into the band hall upon return.

Podiums – Four people will be assigned to podiums. Two will be responsible for the large podium. Rolling it into place and setting it up, lowering it and removing it from the field. The remaining two will each have a small podium to set-up and place and then remove when the performance is complete.

Pit – Typically four people are assigned to help with pit equipment to assist with getting all the instruments to the sideline and back off the field once the performance is over.

Sound - Three people are assigned to sound. The sound board and two speaker carts will need to be pushed to the sidelines, set-up, cords ran from speakers to the sound board and connected, and the removed in the same fashion when the performance ends.

Prop Truck – One person will be assigned to drive the prop truck to and from performances. Will be responsible for getting to the performances safely and on-time. This person will be allowed to have a rider accompany them on every trip.



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Waters – Three people will be assigned to distribute bottled water to the students after each performance. Responsible for assuring that the Band Coolers are prepared and iced and loaded on the equipment trailer.

Barriers – The number of people assigned to barriers will be determined later as the show is set to the field. Each person assigned to a barrier will be responsible for pushing it to the assigned location and setting it up correctly and the removing it from the field once the performance is over.

Props – The number of people assigned to props will be determined by the show. Each person assigned will be responsible for placement prior to the performance and removal from the field upon completion.

Senior Banners – A group of non-senior parents that will be responsible for hanging all the Senior banners in the Stadium for all home games. All supplies needed to hang the banners will be provided.

Medical – One person who is certified in First Aid//CPR and AED applications will be assigned to care for the Band students for all travel events. This person is responsible for the health records of each student and administering over-the-counter medications only and verifying no allergies to said medications. Must be aware of special needs for students to assist with coordinating care if needed.

These tasks are ones that have been assigned through years and help the Band program perform for all the marching events. Please ask questions if you have any regarding these roles and we look forward to a great marching season.
